BEEF, HOG & SHEEP
BARN RULES

1. All morning pen cleaning and feeding chores **MUST BE COMPLETED NO LATER** than 9:00 am. Barns open for viewing @ 9:00 am.
2. All evening chores **MUST BE COMPLETED** between 4:00 and 6:00 pm.
3. No food pans are to be left in pens past chore times.
4. Aisles must be cleaned and swept. Nothing is to be left in the aisles (chairs, shovel, brooms, etc.)
5. All exhibitors are responsible for taking care of their own animal each day of the fair.
6. Be sure your animal(s) has **CLEAN** water at all times.
7. Be respectful to fellow exhibitors and guests alike.
8. Your animal(s) is on display. Visitors are our guests and they should have a clean, pleasant barn to view.

The Barn Superintendent will enforce cleaning of pens, or there will be a charge for someone else to do the cleaning for you.
