

## **Camping Regulations**

**The Dickinson County Fair must attempt to meet the campground requirements enforced by the Michigan Department of Public Health. For this reason, the following regulations have been approved by the Dickinson County Fair Board and must be followed by those camping on the fair grounds:**

1. Camping superintendent shall assign designated campsites by number. Preferences will be given to those requesting camping reservations for 6 or more days.
2. Electrical hookups are available. Electrical cords can not be plugged into any barns where animals are housed due to safety hazards.
3. Water outlets are available in camping areas. Gray water shall not be discharged onto the ground.
4. Each campsite shall not be occupied by more than one family or one camping unit consisting of more than eight people. At least one adult person, 21 years of age or older, shall be present at the campsite to supervise minors present.
5. All camping units must have a least FOUR FEET between units. This includes when slide outs are extended, if so equipped. ALL SEWER DISCHARGE LINES MUST BE CAPPED.
6. Camping superintendent shall supervise and will have full charge of the camping areas, assign location, collect fees and issue permits. The camping permit shall be displayed in the front window of the camping unit at all times.
7. Camping fees are \$100.00 for the duration of the fair (Wednesday thru Monday). An additional \$20.00 will be charged for each day prior to Wednesday or after 6:00 pm on Monday if unit is hooked to power or water.
8. ATV's including golf carts, are not allowed on the fairgrounds except those used by the fair employees. Special use permit grant by fairboard only.
9. Horses or other livestock are not allowed in the campground area at any time.
10. Dogs are allowed in the camping area but must be leashed and owners shall be responsible for cleanup and removal of their dog's wastes.
11. Parties not meeting camping requirements or refusing to purchase a camping permit will be REMOVED FROM THE GROUNDS.
12. Campfires are permitted in fire rings only and must not be left unattended.
13. Quiet time is from 11pm to 7am.
14. Only vehicles with camp parking permits can park in the campgrounds. There is a limit of 2 vehicles per campsite. NO PARKING BY THE BARNES.
15. All vehicles with passes must enter & exit the campgrounds through the back gate off of Fairview Drive.
